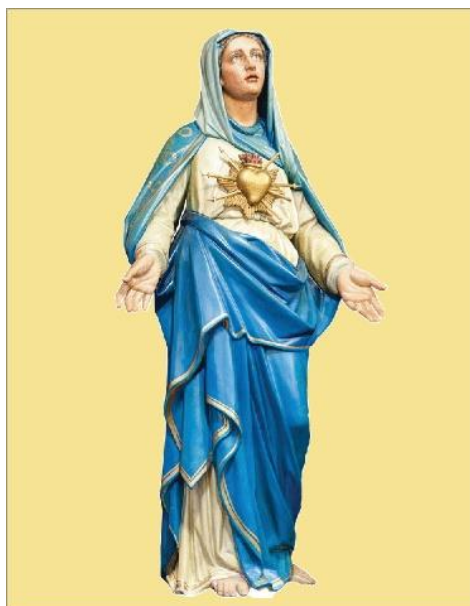

## Message ARIZONA ROSARY CELEBRATION Chairman Lawrence G. Costanzo General Chairman, Arizona Rosary Celebration

Planning for this year's Arizona Rosary Celebration, honoring Mary under her title "Our Lady of Sorrows", is progressing with the anticipation of having the event at the Cathedral in Tucson and the Convention Center in Phoenix. Please keep praying to Our Lady of Sorrows to intercede for us in eradicating this dreaded illness. It would be a joyful time if our Rosary Celebration could include prayers of thanks for bringing all of us out of this pandemic. In the meantime, we are planning for a live presentation at both venues.

### "What's the Plan?"

Our plan for both the Tucson and the Phoenix events looks like this:

- Saturday, October 16th. The Tucson event will be held in St. Augustine Cathedral, under the Diocesan participation and health restrictions in force at the time. Committee planning meetings have begun.
- Sunday, October 17th. The Phoenix event will be held at the Phoenix Convention Center under the Diocesan participation and health restrictions in force at the time. The first Committee Chairperson meetings have been scheduled and are posted elsewhere in this Newsletter.

### "Who's the Guest Speaker?"

Reverend Wilfred Raymond, CSC, President of Holy Cross Family Ministries, headquartered in Easton, MA, will be our guest speaker this year. Ordained in 1971, he is celebrating 50 years as a Holy Cross Father this year. Our Lady of Sorrows happens to be a patron of the Congregation of the Holy Cross (CSC) priests and religious, so it is especially fitting to have Fr. Willy as our guest speaker.

We just got word this morning from a City of Phoenix representative that we will be able to proceed with holding our celebration at the Civic Center without any restrictions on the number of attendees. We will have one restriction and that is to wear a mask if you have not been fully vaccinated. We will also be providing sanitizing stations around the center for your protection and convenience. In addition to the Rosary recitation and Benediction, the procession, the altar server luncheon, confessions, tables, all the normal events will be allowed.

This is the green light that we needed to rev up the engines on our programs. We need to energize and implement our plans for all the things that we would have done by this time in a normal year. We are now working on hard copy flyers, post cards, etc. and will have a distribution plan in place shortly and the website will be updated.
