While Pope Francis has made popular the title for Mary Untier of Knots through his personal devotion to her under this title, it actually stretches back to the 17th century! The church of St. Peter in Perlock, Germany, houses a beautiful painting of Mary where she unties the knots woven by the sins of humanity. The painting was inspired by a meditation of St. Irenaeus who borrows from St. Paul's vision of Jesus as the New Adam.

St. Irenaeus likewise depicts Mary as the New Eve. Irenaeus asserts that humanity's great knot of disgrace was tied through Eve. But through her great act of obedience, Mary has untied the knot! Inspired by this, faithful Catholics have fled to Mary under this title for generations, asking that she help to untie the knots of our lives caused by our sins, failings, or even circumstances beyond our control.

I look forward to joining with the faithful of Arizona to venerate our Blessed Mother, Untier of Knots. May our time together lead us more deeply into the mystery of Her great love for us and the call to love one another.

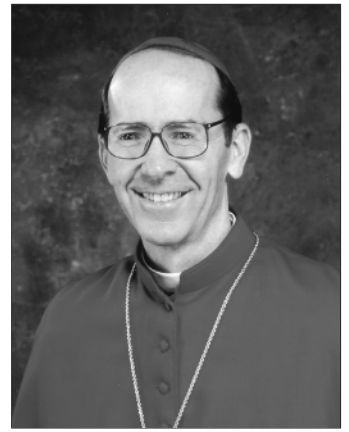

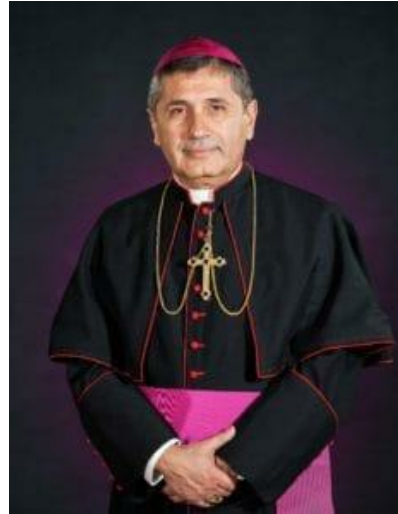

Most Reverend Jorge Rodriguez
Auxiliary Bishop
Archdiocese of Denver, Colorado

Auxiliary Bishop Rodriguez was born March 22, 1955, in Merida, Mexico, located in the state of Yucatan. He was ordained Dec. 24, 1987.

He has a licentiate in philosophy and a doctorate in theology from the Gregorian University in Rome, in addition to a diploma in Mariology from the Marianum in Rome. He speaks English, Spanish, and Italian.

He was a professor and dean of the faculty of philosophy at the Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum in Rome, Italy, until 1999, when he was named Associate Pastor of St. Therese Parish in Aurora, Colorado, by then Archbishop Charles Chaput of Denver.



From 2007-2014, he served as Vice Rector of St. John Vianney Theological Seminary in Denver. He was incardinated as a priest of the Archdiocese of Denver in 2008. He will continue to serve as pastor of Holy Cross Parish.

Auxiliary Bishop Rodriguez is the second Hispanic auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Denver. Archbishop José Gomez served in Denver as the auxiliary bishop from 2001-2005.

The last auxiliary bishop to serve in Denver was Bishop James Conley (ordained a bishop in 2008), who was named the bishop of the Diocese of Lincoln in 2012.

Bishop-elect Jorge Rodriguez was installed as the sixth auxiliary bishop for the Archdiocese of Denver on Nov. 4, 2016, at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception.

Denver became a diocese on Aug. 16, 1887, and an archdiocese on Nov. 15, 1941. The Denver Archdiocese covers 40,000 square miles in northern Colorado and includes 25 counties. Approximately 52% of the Catholics of northern Colorado are Hispanic.

The Icon, History, and Devotion to Mary, Undoer of Knots

As individuals and as a nation we all have knots in our lives—problems and struggles for which we cannot see a solution. Certain situations, dilemmas, or mental disorders, no matter how large or small, require divine intervention. Christians of the apostolic faith have always known that the best prayer partner to have in this struggle is Mary, the Mother of Jesus and (as proclaimed by the Second Vatican Council) ‘Mother of the Church’.



From the moment Jesus bequeathed His Mother to the faithful from the cross, with the words, “BEHOLD THY MOTHER” (John 19:27), enlightened Christians have understood the special bond Christ established between Mary and all believers in Christ. Through our Baptism, Jesus’ Mother has become our Mother, and the concern we feel for our own temporal welfare and eternal salvation have become her maternal concern.

As early as AD 180, Saint Irenaeus of Lyon, in his writings ‘*Against the Heretics*’, first referred to the Virgin Mary as ‘*The Undoer of Knots*’ because, in her obedience to the angelic invitation to become the mother of the Savior, Mary undid the knot that Adam and Eve tied by their disobedience. Thus, the title of *Undoer of Knots* is perhaps one of the oldest and most profound titles given to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

A German variation of this devotion links to the Marian devotion of Our Lady of the Snows and the miracle attributed to her of reconciling failing marriages. Images of *Mary, Undoer of Knots* vary from romanticized Baroque paintings, with ribbons and angels fluttering about, to the calm theologized style portrayed in the Byzantine Icon chosen for this year’s celebration. But whatever style meets your preference the message of ‘*Mary, Undoer of Knots*’ is the same: To have a devotion to Mary under the title of ‘*Undoer of Knots*’ is not just to seek divine assistance for a particular problem, but first and foremost to consecrate ourselves to imitating her obedience to God plan of salvation.

Mary desires to assist us in untying the knots of our own sinfulness: those vices, habits, and addictions that bind us -- keeping us from enjoying the freedom of the children of God. Mary, like all mothers, cares deeply for our temporal welfare and knows well how problems of this world can distract us from “*keeping our minds on things above, where Christ is seated at God’s right hand.*” (Colossians 3:2)

In reading the Icon of *Mary, Undoer of Knots*, the keen eye will note that the ribbon of knots forms the border of the icon and that, as the knotted ribbon flows through the hands of Mary and Jesus, the knots are thoroughly undone. Pope Francis, in offering this devotion to the Universal Church, said, “*Through Mary, Undoer of Knots, all the knots of our broken hearts and wounded consciences and insurmountable problems can be overcome and undone.*”

Celebrating the Centenary of a Great Saint: Remembering Saint John Paul II

The Church and the world celebrated the life and legacy of Saint John Paul II on May 18th, the centenary of his birth. It was a time to remember the legion of contributions this great saint has bestowed on the Church and to renew his vision for the century before us. Pope Francis, marking the occasion during the coronavirus pandemic with the first public gathering at St. Peter's Basilica since the lockdown of Rome, called our attention to three signature legacies of St. John Paul II; the depth of his prayer, his closeness to people, and his vision of justice with mercy.

Saint John Paul II was first and foremost a man of prayer. Prayer was and always had been central to his spiritual life. His daily routine was saturated with prayer, beginning with Morning Prayer and the Liturgy of the Hours, followed by an hour of private prayer, meditations and adoration, the Angelus at noon and frequent petitions to the saints for intercession. The Rosary was his favorite prayer, to which he devoted an Apostolic Letter and gave the Church the Luminous Mysteries to deepen our personal relationship with Christ. At the dawn of the new millennium, he set forward a program for the renewal of the Church in a deeper spirit prayer, centered on contemplating the face of Christ so that we might know Christ and show Him to the world. As he implored the young on World Youth Day, "prayer, intimate dialogue with the One who is calling you to be his disciples, must come first. Be generous in your active life, young people, and be deeply immersed in the contemplation of God's mystery."

Saint John Paul II had a deep and genuine love for people, rooted in a clear vision of the inherent dignity of the human person as created in the image of God. Those who met Saint John Paul II often remember the intensity of the encounter, the warmth and focus he gave to everyone he met. He deeply and genuinely loved people, all people. His missionary spirit set a new standard for future popes with his passionate outreach to all the world. He frequently travelled to be close to the faithful and preach the gospel, visiting 129 countries and 879 cities throughout his 26-year papacy. He established world youth day to strengthen the faith of young people, the Church's future. He promoted ecumenical dialogue and fostered prayer for unity among all Christians and prayer for peace with peoples of all faiths.

He is remembered as a Pope who sought justice, a true, wholistic justice rooted in mercy, where every person is valued as being created in the image of God. A justice rooted in solidarity, subsidiarity, and genuine love among people. A justice borne of God, in the passionate mercy in which God reaches out to humanity with love. A clear vision that man's hope of salvation is ultimately found in God's merciful love poured out on all of humanity, in contrast to the human suffering resulting from godless political ideologies and revolutions inflicted on the world in the 20th Century.

Prayer, love, and mercy. John Paul II's legacy has so many facets and has impacted virtually every aspect of the modern Church, but these three alone speak volumes. Many are calling him "John Paul the Great." Only time will tell if this epithet prevails. But with Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, we can all truly say that "God's power and goodness have become visible to all of us in John Paul II."
