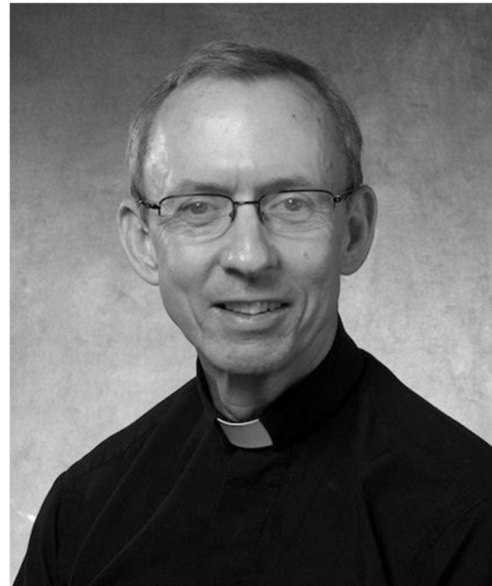

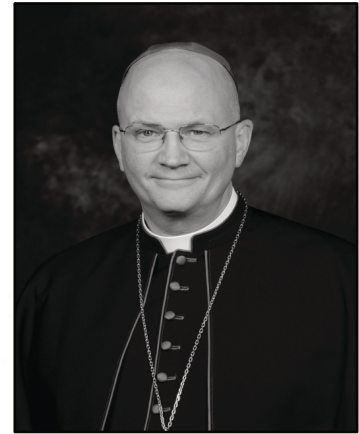

The persecution of Christians in Africa has continued unabated, especially in Nigeria, where the West African branch of ISIS, and other anti-Christian entities have murdered more than 55,000 Christians since 2010 and where nearly half of all religiously motivated murders of Christians occurred in 2020. Religious persecution in East Asia is enabled by dictatorial regimes that reject the tenets of religious freedom and enact punitive laws that ban religion, decree certain practices illegal, or subvert religious observances in favor of fealty to the state.

Jesus told his disciples that to follow Him meant giving up all their worldly possessions, and to even laying down their very lives for their faith. Every year the number of martyrs grows, as those espousing evil under the twisted guise of their beliefs in God seek to eradicate from the world those whose faith is rooted in Christ the Word made flesh.

Our Lady stood firmly at the foot of the Cross and shared the suffering of her Divine Son. She also stands with us, prays and weeps with us; she consoles us and teaches us to persevere in hope. Mary is aware that before God, she is nothing and can do nothing except by His power. The reason why Mary stood firm and courageous at the foot of the Cross is because she is "full of grace", full of God, full of the One who is stronger than any evil or suffering. She is constantly overshadowed by the Holy Spirit, who filled her with the gifts of courage and hope. St. John Paul II Catholic High School will be providing the music for this year's Arizona Rosary Celebration under the direction of Derek James Stull. The group performing is the Chamber Choir, the premier vocal ensemble at the school. This choir in its second year is composed of students who have auditioned to be eligible for selection in the ensemble.

The mission of St. John Paul II Catholic High School is to provide an educational environment that promotes a personal encounter with Jesus Christ through prayer, study, community, and service as disciples. This mission is carried out through the leadership of the Dominican Sisters of Saint Cecelia who serve both in administration as well as in classroom teaching. In its fifth year the school currently serves 360 students in grades 9 through 12, and continued growth is anticipated for years to come.



Our Lady Help of Persecuted Christians

Catholics have always turned to the Blessed Mother for help in times of crisis, turmoil, or anguish. Our Lady, Help of Christians was originated in 1576 and later instituted as a feast by Pope Pius VII after his release from a Napoleonic prison. A recent addition to the powerful icons, images, and statuary of Mary that are often the focus of our intercessory prayers, is Our Lady Help of Persecuted Christians.

In a resolution of the Knights of Columbus during its 2021 Supreme Convention the Knights reaffirmed that in the past 20 years people of faith have been widely targeted for persecution around the world (including our own country).

The resolution recalls that in 2016, the Knights of Columbus played a major role in the United States' declaration that condemned genocide against Christians and other religious minorities in the Middle East. The persecution of Christians in Africa has continued unabated, especially in Nigeria, where anti-Christian entities have murdered more than 55,000 Christians since 2010 and where nearly half of all religiously motivated murders of Christians occurred in 2020.

This extreme level of religious persecution prompted the Knights of Columbus to dedicate, during the 2018-2019 fraternal year, its 18th Marian Prayer Program to "Our Lady, Help of Persecuted Christians" to encourage all Knights of Columbus families to pray that the Blessed Mother intercede on behalf of all those persecuted for their faith in her divine Son. As a result, the Knights of Columbus stands firmly in its solidarity with all Christians around the world who are suffering from violent persecution and calls upon all Christians and people of good will to do the same.



As part of the Marian Prayer Program, the Knights commissioned Italian artist Fabrizio Diomedì to create a unique icon that captured the essence and plight of the persecuted who take refuge beneath the loving shelter of Mary's cloak. The Marian prayer program pays particular attention to the suffering of today's Christians in the Middle East. Iconographer Fabrizio Diomedì depicted the Blessed Mother, with the Child Jesus over her heart, spreading her protective mantle around a representative gathering of recent Christian martyrs—men and women, young and old, from East and West; priests, religious and laypersons, including one of the six priest-members of the Knights of Columbus who were killed by the Mexican government in the first half of the 20th century. The four crosses represent an "ecumenism of blood" among martyrs of Roman and Eastern Catholicism, as well as those of Coptic, Armenian, Syriac and Orthodox traditions.

In an internet article posted by the Handmaids of the Precious Blood, "Honoring Our Lady, Help of Persecuted Christians" the sisters report on the visit of one of the Knights' Icons. The article describes that "when one looks at the figures huddled under Mary's royal blue mantle, they see representatives from around the world and from various Churches and ethnicities. But, like a news photo, faces and clothing are seen that cannot fail to bring to mind martyrs known by name already, even if they haven't been formally canonized. Indeed, many living martyrs now have been persecuted all their lives." (Handmaid, <https://nunsforpriests.org/>, January 14, 2019)

Fierce persecution around the globe fosters Christianity

Local priests attest to ongoing struggle, explosion of faith.

“Without the Eucharist, Christians in Iraq cannot survive.”

These were the words uttered by Fr. Ragheed Ganni, a young Chaldean Catholic priest martyred in Mosul, Iraq, alongside three subdeacons in 2007. With his cause for beatification open, Fr. Ganni may soon be among those the Church calls “blessed.”

The Diocese of Phoenix is home to 1,000 Chaldean Catholics who worship in two parishes and one mission, all belonging to the Chaldean Diocese of St. Peter based in San Diego. The Chaldeans belong to one of 22 Eastern Rite Catholic Churches, many of them with members living in the Phoenix Diocese.

Bishop Felix Shabi of Zakho, Iraq, was once Corbishop of the Arizona Chaldean Vicariate. Fr. Ganni was the cousin of Bishop Shabi’s mother. “We have the blood of martyrs running in our veins,” Bishop Shabi told The Catholic Sun in a previous interview.

Even after receiving repeated death threats, Fr. Ganni was determined to continue offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for his parishioners. On June 3, 2007, as he and the three subdeacons walked away from Holy Spirit Parish, they were approached by gunmen. One of them demanded to know why Fr. Ganni, after being warned earlier, hadn’t closed the church.

“How can I close the house of God?” Fr. Ganni replied. The armed men demanded that Fr. Ganni and his companions convert to Islam. For their refusal, they were fatally shot.

Fr. Peter Patros, ordained to the priesthood in 2019, was appointed pastor of Mar Abraham Chaldean Catholic Church in Scottsdale and administrator of Holy Cross Chaldean Catholic Mission in Gilbert July 7. Fr. Patros’ parents and five older siblings left Iraq when it was embroiled in war.

“My family fled war-torn Iraq I the early 90s—fled on foot in the middle of the night from Zakho to Turkey to live in refugee camps for a few years until they found asylum in ’03 in America,” Fr. Patros said.

Though born in the U.S., Fr. Patros carries within him the legacy of persecution and martyrdom. Referring to Acts, Chapter 4, in which the Apostles Peter and John refused to be silenced by the authorities and continue to preach the Good News, Fr. Patros

Thousands of miles away in the safety of parishes in the Diocese of Phoenix, scenes like this seem surreal. Tragically, they are not so uncommon. From Afghanistan to North Korea and Nicaragua to Nigeria, across the globe followers of Christ are undergoing brutal persecution.

In Nigeria, for example, thousands of Christians have been killed by the jihadist group Boko Haram and Fulani herdsmen. Fifteen priests from Nigeria currently serve in the Diocese of Phoenix. Fr. Fidelis Igwenwanne is one of them. He serves as a chaplain at the Carl T. Hayden Veterans' Administration Medical Center in Phoenix, said he knew some of the priests who were kidnapped and/or killed in his homeland.

"In Nigeria, Christians witness to their faith every day through shedding their blood," Fr. Igwenwanne said. "Some people think it is like a fantasy, or a remote story of something that happened many, many years ago and is out of reach. No. It still is happening."

In fact, so many priests have been kidnapped in Nigeria, he said, that the country's bishops refuse to pay ransoms or engage in negotiations to secure the release of clergy.

"What the abductors or kidnapers are asking for is money, money, money and negotiations with the Church. The bishops are saying, 'You can't negotiate with the Devil,'" Fr. Igwenwanne said.

What is happening in Nigeria is a constant reminder of the famous adage that "the blood of martyrs is the seed of the Church," Fr. Igwenwanne noted. He hasn't traveled to Nigeria since 2015 when his father died.

"I don't like going home because of that trouble. Each time I go home, I hide."

It's a perspective that few Americans can fathom and yet the call to solidarity with the persecuted Church urges vigilant intercession.

"Continue praying. Put it in your daily prayers, to pray for persecuted Christians."

A Little about the Matachines and Ballet Folklórico Dancers

The dance of the matachines is originally a European dance, known in the Old World since the 15th century and brought to the Americas by Spaniards. Throughout the northern part of Mexico it is the most popular form of religious dance among indigenous groups. The variety and meaning of the costumes is specific to the cultures and places represented. Dance groups are made up of family, friends, and members of parish groups, and children, teens, and adults participate. The attire combines various religious images and cultural adornments that make every dance a moment that shines. In this event, the tradition of ballet folklórico also is represented. The group “Esto es México,” “This is Mexico,” is using colorful costuming in honor of Mexican culture, as a reminder of and dedication to the joy of Mexican traditional customs. The culture of Peru is represented by the ballet folklórico group “Sunqu Guadalupano,” “Guadalupean Heart,” demonstrating pre-Inca indigenous culture with costumes typical of Cuzco, Peru. For all of the dancers, it’s a great joy to participate in our Diocese of Phoenix Arizona Rosary Celebration.

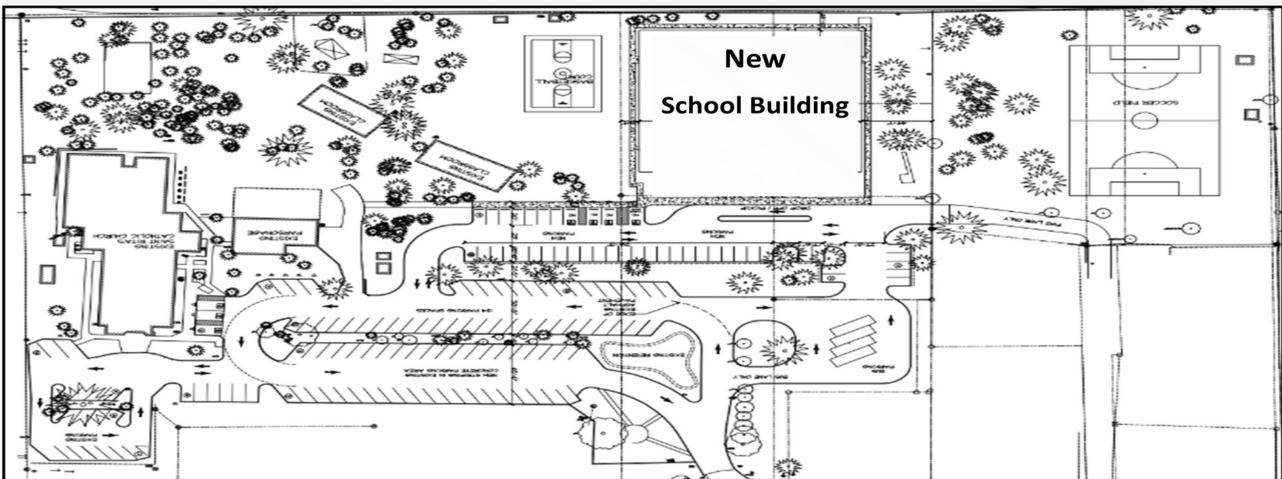
